Can I create playlists?	<p align="center">NO</p> <p align="center">You can only display defined slides.</p>	<p align="center">YES</p> <p align="center">Create as many playlists as you want, based on either an event or special content. Display whenever you need.</p>
Can I schedule what to display and when?	<p align="center">NO</p> <p align="center">Anything new or different requires reload.</p>	<p align="center">YES</p> <p align="center">You can schedule as many playlists as you like. Have them play anytime in the future.</p>
Can I play multi-media?	<p align="center">LIMITED</p> <p align="center">You can show graphics files, anything other than requires drivers</p>	<p align="center">YES</p> <p align="center">Any graphics files, as well as any MP3, MP4, MOV, FLS ...etc.,</p>
Can I dynamically redefine screen layout?	<p align="center">NO</p> <p align="center">The only way to redefine the screen layout is to redesign all of the slides</p>	<p align="center">YES</p> <p align="center">At any time, with just 2 clicks you can redesign the entire screen layout without touching the content.</p>
Can I display RSS feeds?	<p align="center">NO</p>	<p align="center">YES</p> <p align="center">Simply define the RSS feed to use and use it just like any other piece of content.</p>
Can I trigger display based on some event?	<p align="center">NO</p>	<p align="center">YES</p> <p align="center">We are adding triggers all the time, can also integrate with ILS.</p>
